RURAL COMMUNITY IMMIGRATION PILOT PROJECT

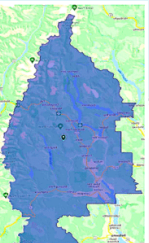
The Rural Community Immigration Pilot (RCIP) is a Canadian immigration program designed to help communities in rural and smaller areas attract skilled workers to fill key jobs and encourage long-term residency.

British Columbia (BC) participates in the RCIP through various communities and pilot programs, including the **North Okanagan-Shuswap** and the **West Kootenay Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot**.

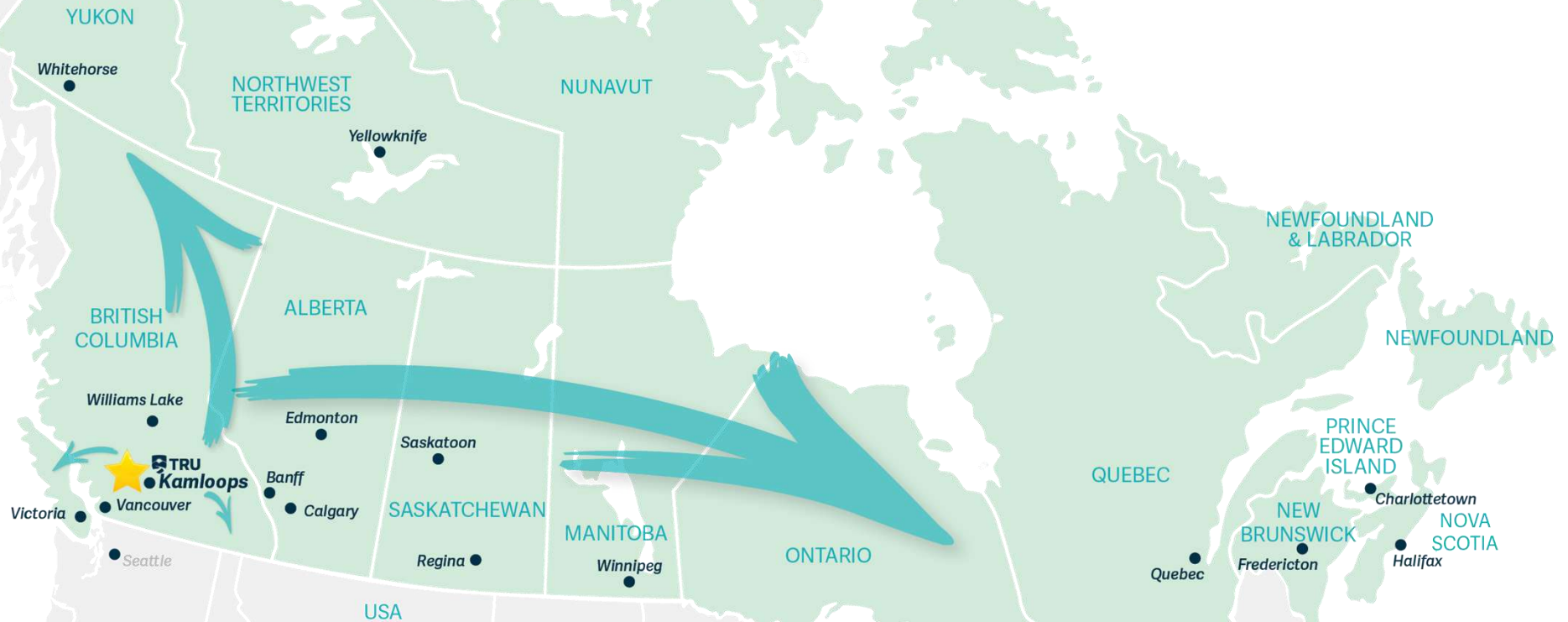


The RCIP Community boundary for the North Okanagan-Shuswap includes:
