## Plumbing (Post-Secondary) (2026)

### **Purpose of the Challenge:**

To assess the competitors' knowledge and skills of plumbing materials and assemblies with high regard to the aspects of quality, workmanship and accuracy of work within a specified time frame.

### **Skills & Knowledge to be Tested:**

- Application of Mathematical concepts involving piping and piping layouts
- Reading and interpreting diagrams and specifications
- Assembly of pipe and fittings, consisting of:
  - Copper soft solder (lead free)
  - Use of Cast Iron pipe
  - Use of system 15 drainage and vent pipe
- Measurements to be taken from horizontal and vertical bench marks
- Safe work practices.

- B tank and torch
- Tri-pod
- Cordless drill
- Adhesives and cements
- Sand cloth
- Pastes
- Soldering materials
- Pipe cutters for copper pipe
- Deburring tool

### **Safety**

- It is mandatory for all competitors to wear CSA approved eyewear (including side shields for prescription eyewear).
- It is mandatory for all competitors to wear CSA approved footwear
- Jewelry such as rings, bracelets and necklaces or any items deemed unsafe by the Judges shall be removed.
- Proper shop attire is to be worn (no loose straps, baggy sleeves). Any attire that is deemed unsafe by the Judges will not be permitted.
- Competition Judges will have final authority over matters of safety.
- Competitors should be under the age of 29 years and tied to the school through training (i.e. apprenticeship)

Quality of Workmanship	30%
Pressure Testing	10%
Safety	10%
Total	100%
