

SoTL Dissemination Fund Call for Applications

The SoTL Dissemination Fund supports dissemination activities of faculty and their TRU research assistants. Applicants may only receive the travel award a **maximum** of once every two years. Priority for this fund is given to faculty that have completed the New SoTL Scholars Program and have not previously received support from the dissemination fund.

Value of the Award

Travel grants are awarded for up to \$1000. Details on what expenses are eligible for this grant are provided in the SoTL Grant Funding Guidelines document, available on CELT's website.

Reporting Requirements

Grant holders will be required to provide a report on their dissemination activity. The report is due 6-weeks after the approved dissemination activity. Researchers that do not submit their reports to CELT in a timely manner will not be eligible for future awards.

How to apply?

Faculty in tenured, tenure-track, or LTC (bipartite & tripartite) positions are invited to submit a completed application form (available on CELT's website). Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis each year until the fund is exhausted. Applications not funded in one review period may be held for consideration in a subsequent review.
